Critical Industry Employee Authorization to Travel Regardless of the Time of Day

March 24, 2020

To Whom It May Concern:

The individual in possession of this letter works in the construction industry and must travel to and from work and engage in his or her work activities regardless of the time of day as an employee in a sector that has been deemed by the U.S. Government as critical to the infrastructure of the United States.

The construction industry is essential for the continued function of the economy in this time of crisis. This individual is engaged in contracting services essential to the continued function of multiple Critical Infrastructure Industries, including healthcare, government, education, manufacturing and food and agriculture. It is essential that this individual be permitted to proceed to or from his or her job or to otherwise perform his or her job function.

The construction industry is designated a "Critical Infrastructure Segment" under Presidential Policy Directive 21 and Department of Homeland Security emergency readiness programs implementing the USA PATRIOT Act of 2001. 42 U.S.C. § 5195c (e). It is the policy of the United States government that these industries continue to function with minimal disruption in the event of an emergency.

As such, the individual in possession of this letter is a "critical infrastructure industry employee" and should be considered exempt from any state or local restrictions such as curfews, shelter-in-place orders, and other mobility restrictions when reporting to, returning from, or performing his or her work functions. Multi-Craft Contractors, Inc. requests that this person be given safe and expedited passage. Please allow this individual to continue with his or her job in the interest of protecting public health and security.
